




Floating Base - Bed Assembly Instructions

(please retain this instruction for future reference)


To assemble your bed you have been supplied with eight (12) button head bolts, 2 x 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ screws and an Allen key.

Steps:

- Connect the side rails to the bed head and bed foot by hooking the side rail brackets onto the head and foot bracket. NOTE: Make sure side rails are attached so that two button head bolts (already attached to side rails) are at the foot end of the bed.
- 2. Screw three button head bolts loosely into the holes on the bracket on the bed head and bed foot.
- 3. Tighten the button head bolts only finger tight.



4. Remove two button head bolts (already attached to side rails) from foot end of each side rail. Lift the base frame and position floating leg rail into position. NOTE: Holes on each end of the floating leg rail must line up with the holes on the side rails.



- 5. Using the button head bolts secure (finger tight) floating base assembly rail into position
- 6. Ensure that the bed is sitting square and then tighten all button head bolts using the Allen key.
- 7. To properly set up the slat and spine system (foundation system King, Queen and Double size Beds), proceed to "Instructions for Slats Supports for Bed". Ensure that you place slat with hole in either end at the center of your bed. When finished we recommend that you use the 2 x 1 ¼" screws (supplied) and screw through this slat into the cleats

NOTES:

- Button head bolts should be regularly inspected and may need to be retightened after a period of time.
- Never drag or move assembled bed as this may damage the bed

CARE & MAINTENANCE:

Your Silver Lynx product is crafted with care, properly maintained, it will mature over time developing a rich deep patina enhancing its appearance. To get the best performance from your Silver Lynx product, please follow the simple care instructions listed below.

- * Do not use silicone based polishes/cleaners at any time.
- * Dust surfaces gently with a feather duster then wipe gently with a slightly damp cloth/chamois.
- * Do not allow liquids, damp clothes to remain in contact with lacquered surface for extended periods.
- * Never place furniture in close proximity to heating outlets.
- * Exposure to direct sunlight will cause color fading to fabrics, leathers and timber finishes.
- * Do not allow solvents, abrasives or heated objects to come in contact with the suite.






AMENDMENT TO INSTRUCTIONS FOR ALL SILVER LYNX BEDS

Positioning of Support Tubes and Number of Support Tubes for your bed.

Due to the design of this product, Silver Lynx advises that the following position is the ideal location for the support tubes in Silver Lynx Beds.







Foundation System - Installation Instruction for King, Queen and Double size beds



To install your Foundation System to your bed you have been supplied with following:

- 12 x timber slats (part no:1)
- 1 x red spine (King size bed will have 2 x red spines) (part no:2)
- 2 x support bars (part no:3)inc. end tabs and bolts (part no:4) for Queen and King size beds


(Double size bed will have 1x support bar supplied) (part no:3)

 1 x Support leg (part no:5) for Queen size bed (King size bed will have 4 x support leg supplied)




Steps:


1. Fit 12 x timber slats to the red spine. After all slats have been fitted, position the red spine in the middle, as per photo below. <u>Ensure that you place slat with hole in either end at the center of your bed</u>.




2. Attach end tab(s) to support bar(s) - ONLY on one end



- 3. Fit the support bar(s) to the spine. Make sure to attach support leg(s) to the support bar(s) before you slide support bar(s) through red spine.
 - For the position of the support bars refer to "Amendment to instructions for all Silver Lynx Beds".
 - Install support leg to the support bar that is as central as possible.



4. Attach other end tab to black support bar



- 5. Approximately set up the support leg height to fit your bed height using either of the two different bolt positions. Using bolt and nut lock the leg in to position.
- 6. Position complete foundation system on to your bed.
- 7. Fine tune support leg so it sits approximately about 5 15 mm of the floor.
- 8. When finished we recommend that you use the $2 \times 1 \frac{1}{4}$ screws (supplied) and screw the slat with hole in either end (centre slat) into the cleats.
